
And now, on to our next sporting event . . .

#### We Believe:

- that three days after His crucifixion, Jesus came out of the grave in bodily form, and then ascended into heaven. (Luke 24:36-43; 1 Cor. 15:4; Mark 16:19)
- that the Bible teaches that God's plan of salvation is to hear God's Word, to believe His Word to be true, to repent of the sin in your life, to confess that Jesus is God's Son, and to be immersed in baptism. (Luke 13:5; Rom. 10:9-10; Luke 24:45-47; Acts 2:38; Rom. 6:1-7; 2 Peter 3:9)
- that the Holy Spirit dwells within every Christian. (John 16:5-15)
- that Jesus Christ is going to come back one day. (John 14:1-3; 1 Thess. 4:14-18)
- that heaven and hell are real, and that there is coming a day of judgment when all people will be held accountable for their behavior; the saved will inherit eternal life; the unsaved, eternal separation from God. (John 5:28-29; John 6:47; Rev. 20:10, 15; Rev. 21:2-5, 27)
- that the church is the body and Bride of Christ, founded on the Day of Pentecost, consisting of all Christians everywhere. (Matt. 16:13-18; Acts 2:14-47)
